

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Program Assessment Template

Purpose: This template is intended to help supervisors or evaluators of PPE programs in clinical and public health laboratory settings. The goal is to determine whether appropriate policies and procedures are in place to enable employees to safely and effectively use PPE. This template should be customized to address site-specific needs.

This template is to be used as a supplement to — not a replacement for - a laboratory's established policies or procedures. This is a point-in-time assessment. Ongoing reevaluation is recommended on a predetermined schedule governed by the laboratory. If feasible, direct observation of PPE practices is encouraged.



How to use: Complete each section by answering Yes (Y) or No (N) regarding compliance with each statement. Use the Notes column to provide additional comments if needed. Calculate the number of Y and N responses for each section. The total responses and overall score are calculated in the Scoring and Calculations section. Compare the scores to those from previous assessments. Finally, comments or corrective actions must be listed to address deficiencies.

to evaluate employee's understanding and skill of		
proper PPE use.		
Written certification for each person evaluated for		
PPE competency includes the name of the person		
assessed, along with the date, subject, and the		
result of the assessment, as well as signatures of		
the person being assessed and the assessor.		
All training and competency documentation is		
current for each employee.
